"A Dose of Painting" consists of three phases:

First phase is organizing workshops for children staying at the hospital, carried out by lecturers and students of the Academy of Fine Arts. During the workshops, Children create 3D sculptures on a given subject using plasticine. Previous editions of the project included subjects such as: 'Garden', 'Outer space', 'Outside my window'. Children learn how to express their ideas through art and its various media. The aim of this task is to stimulate and encourage creativity and making an effort to brighten up the Children's hospital reality, and make them interested in fine arts through cooperative work with painters.

The second phase is painting a picture, which takes place outside the hospital and is based on reinterpreting the world created by the Children in the objects they had made in the first phase. Fine Arts Academy students and other volunteers chosen by the Organizer will transfer artistic vision of the patients onto the canvas under the watchful eye of the Artist, Marcin Kowalik. Formally, such painting applies to the "work within a work" rule. The Children's artistic concepts are reinterpreted by the volunteers and "polished" by dr Marcin Kowalik, who gives the image a final touch.

The last, third phase is devoting the painting to the Hospital during the official unveiling. The painting becomes the property of the Hospital, can either decorate its walls or be offered for sale at charity auction to get funds to help children and the Hospital.

The Hospital will choose a place for official unveiling ceremony on its premises and together with the Organizer will decide where to locate the artwork. An information note about the project will be put next to the painting.

Cooperation of both sides on the "Dose of a Painting" project can be cyclical. Collaboration can also relate to other projects with the aim of brightening up the Children's hospital reality.

The Organizer covers all costs.
